



RESPECT @ PETROC POLICY

The Respect @ Petroc policy applies to all students and staff

Everyone who comes to Petroc can expect to be treated with respect and is expected to treat others and the environment with respect also.

The College is fully committed to providing a culture and atmosphere for all which is respectful at all times.

We will challenge all disrespectful behaviours and there will be consequences for behaving in a disrespectful, unacceptable manner.

Petroc adopts a zero tolerance stance for serious and totally unacceptable behaviours, such as bullying, racism, violence and the use of drugs on any of our sites and the most likely result, if this occurs, will be suspension pending further investigation.

Disrespectful behaviours such as littering, smoking outside of designated shelters, spitting and swearing are unacceptable and will be challenged by any staff member present.

The college has a Respect Co-ordinator on campus to support any student who is experiencing disrespectful actions or wishing to report any disrespectful behaviour they have witnessed. This will contribute to ensuring that all who attend Petroc can work and learn in a pleasant, safe and fulfilling environment.
