#### REQUIREMENTS

# Equipment:

- Notebook and general stationery, ie pens, pencils, files, etc
- Bring your own device (mobile phone/tablet/laptop)
- Water to ensure you are properly hydrated during practical sessions
- Suitable practical clothing theatre blacks, including joggers or leggings, black vest top or t-shirt, black sweatshirt or hoody. Loose layered clothing preferable without zips/pockets etc, jazz shoes/daps, hair bands/elastic)
- Dance wear black leotard, black tights
- Dance shoes optional black jazz shoes, tap shoes, ballet shoes, character shoes
- There may be small items you will need to bring in for performances, eg limited costume and props. This will be assessment dependent.

#### Lockers:

We strongly recommend students hire a locker for the academic year. The cost is £8 for the year, which is non-refundable.

# Studio Fee

You will need to pay a studio fee of £100 to cover resources which will add value and breadth to your studies and allow you to train using high quality industry standard equipment. The fee ensures you have access to top of the range resources you will need including, lighting, mixing desks, stage resources, PA's, music and performance rights and much, much more.
