REQUIREMENTS

Equipment:

- For the first day, a selection of pens (biros, fine liners etc). Please come prepared to pay your studio fee if you haven't already, either online or in person by cash or cheque (made payable to Petroc)
- A3 or A4 quality sketchbook, eg Pink Pig or Seawhite
- A range of paint brushes (small size 0 up to large size 18)
- Pair of scissors
- Pencils, rubber, sharpener, gel pens white and black
- Glue sticks, eg Pritt
- Masking tape

Apps/Software:

During your course you need to use, create, or download computer files. We recommend the following:

- Microsoft One Drive phone app - as a student you will automatically receive a one drive account. You can log into it using your college account username and password. Helpful in allowing access to your files on your phone or any device anywhere
- Microsoft Outlook app - as a student you will automatically receive an account. You can log into it using your college account username and password
- Google drive app
- Light painting app - choose any free light painting app for slow shutter photography
- Adobe creative suite/creative cloud - as a student you will be granted a free Adobe creative cloud account. Your lecturer will have to submit your details to our IT department to activate. This will allow you to download and use all Adobe creative suite for free.

Lockers:

We strongly recommend students hire a locker for the academic year. The cost is £8 for the year, which is non-refundable.

FEES AND FUNDING

Studio Fee

You will need to pay a studio fee of £100 each year to cover resources which will add value and breadth to your studies and allow you to train using high quality industry standard equipment. The fee ensures you have access to all the materials and resources you will need including paint, 3D printing, high res cameras, resin, vinyl, clay, wood, canvas, inks, fabrics, photographic studio, darkroom materials, adobe creative cloud access at home and college and much, much more.

Payments can be made online via myPetroc or at the cashier onsite.

Printing

Students are responsible for their own printing and photocopying costs.

Bursary Fund
