

NATIONAL EXTENDED DIPLOMA IN OUTDOOR EDUCATION LEVEL 3

REQUIREMENTS

Equipment:

Land-based activities

- Walking trousers
- Wicking/thermal top
- Fleece top/jumper
- Good quality walking boots
- 50 litre+ rucksack and waterproof liner
- Plastic orange survival bag
- Good quality waterproof trousers and jacket
- Warm hat and gloves
- Climbing shoes
- Head torch

Water-based activities

- Full length winter wetsuit or dry trousers and top
- A good quality 20-30 litre dry bag – to keep spare kit in
- Wetsuit boots

And remember, all courses go out whatever the weather!!

Lockers:

We strongly recommend students hire a locker for the academic year. The cost is £8 for the year, which is non-refundable.

FEES AND FUNDING

Resource Fee

To provide learners with an enhanced learning experience whilst at Petroc, we ask for a small annual £20.00 contribution towards resources, stationery and general consumables used throughout the year.

Activity Fee

You will need to pay an activity fee of £650.00 which will provide you with the opportunity to attend various activities and trips that will provide further insight into your area of study, help you to develop your knowledge and understanding, and support your learning. The fee will also cover the cost of a residential.

The activity fee needs to be paid in full at the start of the course if possible. Payments can be made online via myPetroc. If you plan to apply for bursary, please do so before the course starts.

In addition to your BTEC qualification we often add in some 'extra' courses that are provided by the various National Governing Bodies of the activities we do. These are invaluable to you as, not only do they make you better at the activity, but they are also what is needed by employers and therefore help you to gain paid employment either during or after the course.

The cost of these courses is included in the £650 that you pay each year BUT, in order for you to take part, some NGBs require you to be members and to pay a registration fee/certification fee direct to them.

Please DO NOT take out any memberships/register for any awards unless we confirm that you need to!! This is just to let you know of some possible costs that you might need to budget for. Here are a few examples:

Climbing wall instructor training registration - £49
