REQUIREMENTS

Uniform:

Essential clothing to be ordered from Russums – order form attached

- Work boots
- Petroc branded boiler suit OR
- Action trousers and Petroc branded polo shirt

Optional clothing, strongly recommended – from Russums or suitable alternative

- Viroblock touch gloves
- Core winter parka
- Soft shell jacket
- Hooded sweatshirt
- Baseball cap

To avoid contamination, clothing/footwear worn in the animal centre cannot be worn outside the centre so you will need to bring a change of clothing/footwear. Except for wedding rings, jewellery cannot be worn in the centre. Lockable storage is available.

Please remember that a large amount of animal care activities will take place outside. It is the student's responsibility to dress appropriately for the weather. Any student not dressed appropriately will be asked to leave their practical session and their attendance will not be counted.
