

LEVEL 1 DIPLOMA IN ART, DESIGN & MEDIA

REQUIREMENTS

Equipment for art & design:

- A3 sketchbook
- Memory stick, 1GB minimum
- Pencils 2H-6B and rubber
- Black graphics pen 0.5 or 0.7
- Metal ruler, safety if possible
- Scalpel
- Scissors
- Stapler with staples
- Masking tape
- Glue stick
- Needles and thread
- Water colour set
- Set of acrylic paint tubes and paint palette
- Paint brushes 4, 6, 8 round
- White gel pens
- Apron or old shirt
- Toolbox or other storage for your kit
- Padlock for your locker

You will add items as you go to your essential kit list depending on the direction of your work. Planned workshops will have all the materials you need supplied.

Apps/Software:

During your course you need to use, create, or download computer files. We recommend the following:

- Microsoft One Drive phone app - as a student you will automatically receive a one drive account. You can log into it using your college account username and password. Helpful in allowing access to your files on your phone or any device anywhere
- Microsoft Outlook app - as a student you will automatically receive an account. You can log into it using your college account username and password
- Google drive app
- Light painting app - choose any free light painting app for slow shutter photography
- Adobe creative suite/creative cloud - as a student you will be granted a free Adobe creative cloud account. Your lecturer will have to submit your details to our IT department to activate. This will allow you to download and use all Adobe creative suite for free.

Equipment for media:

Essential:

- Headphones (wired)
- 32GB SD card (preferably SanDisk silver or gold)

Optional:

- Portable drive, minimum 64GB
- Basic stationery (pens, pencils, notepad, etc)

Lockers:

We strongly recommend students hire a locker for the academic year. The cost is £8 for the year, which is non-refundable.
