





QUALIFICATION OPTIONS

Choosing the right qualification is an important step towards your future, and at Petroc, we're here to help you find the best route to match your aspirations and learning style.

Explore the different qualification options below to see which pathway suits you best. Our experienced Advice & Guidance Team are always available to offer support if you need guidance.

A Levels

A Levels are an excellent choice if you prefer a more academic style of learning. Typically studied over two years, most A Levels are assessed through exams, with some including coursework elements.

Choosing A Levels allows you to focus on specific subjects you're passionate about and explore new areas not available at GCSE. They provide a strong foundation for university and require independent study, preparing you for higher education.

At Petroc, students usually take three A Levels, with the option to study a fourth in exceptional circumstances. Alongside classroom learning, you'll have the opportunity to join specialist academies like VETMED, Law, or STEM, enhancing your knowledge and career prospects. All students take part in work experience and work-related learning to support your progression and employability skills along with Petroc Boost - a 12 week enrichment programme - designed to enhance your learning experience and features choices such as Astronomy, Creative Media, Criminology and French - please see page 118 for further details.

Vocational courses

Vocational courses combine **practical learning** with classroom-based teaching and will equip you with practical skills and handson experience, to prepare you for real-world jobs by making you highly employable.

These courses provide valuable work placements and work experience, helping you develop essential workplace and employability skills that employers look for. By choosing a vocational path, you will gain vocational qualifications assessed through a mix of assignments, coursework, and exams to give you a strong foundation for career success, allowing you to progress into further study, university, apprenticeships, or even go straight into employment.

These courses include work experience or industry placements. Available at **Levels** 1, 2, and 3, each stage provides a clear progression route:

- Level 1: A broad introduction to a subject area (one year).
- Level 2: A more focused study of a subject (one year).
- Level 3: In-depth knowledge in a specific field, including T Levels (typically two years). Equivalent to three A Levels, you will receive a qualification after year 1 and then the full qualification after year 2.

Most businesses request Level 3 qualifications when looking for new employees, so we will encourage you to progress in your chosen subject, achieving a Level 3 qualification as a minimum where appropriate.

T Levels

If you're passionate about a specific career and ready to take your skills to the next level, a T Level could be the perfect choice for you. T Levels are two-year qualifications that give you hands-on experience in your chosen industry while you study. Designed in collaboration with employers, they equip you with the skills and knowledge that businesses are looking for - meaning you'll be ready to step into the world of work and make an impact.

T Levels blend classroom learning with practical experience. You'll spend around 80% of your time learning at college and the other 20% working directly with an industry partner through an industry placement of at least 315 hours (the equivalent of around 45 days). This provides a really valuable experience of your chosen industry area, equipping you with relevant and up-to-date skills in preparation for your next steps - whether that is direct employment, an apprenticeship, or further study at university.

These qualifications are developed with input from employers to teach you all the skills that meet the needs of today's job market. A T Level is also **equivalent to three A Levels**, giving you a well-rounded qualification that helps you move smoothly into the workforce or continue your education.

Apprenticeships

If you're ready to start working and earning while learning, an apprenticeship could be the perfect route for you. Apprenticeships combine on-the-job training with off-the-job learning, meaning you gain practical experience while studying towards a recognised qualification.

As an apprentice, you'll spend 80% of your time working with an employer and 20% in training, so you still benefit from a college learning experience. Assessment methods include work observations, tests, and portfoliobased evidence collected throughout the programme.

Most apprenticeships last around 18 months, and after completion, you can progress to higher or degree-level apprenticeships to further develop your skills and qualifications.

WHICH LEVEL IS RIGHT FOR YOU?

UNDERSTANDING QUALIFICATIONS & ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

At Petroc, we're here to help you take the next exciting step after Year 11. Whatever your starting point, Petroc has a pathway to help you grow, build confidence, and progress through qualification levels. Our courses are designed to give you the skills, knowledge, and experience that employers and universities are looking for at a pace which suits you.

Understanding what level or qualification is suitable for you can sometimes feel confusing, so we've created a quick-glance guide to the different levels available - and their related entry requirements.







Entry Level courses help you take the first step towards work or a Level 1 course. They include personalised goals to support your progress to help you move forward and you will continue to study English and Maths.

Entry requirements: No formal qualifications but you will have a one-to-one interview to discuss your learning needs.

Types of course: Progressive Skills, Foundation Year, ESOL, Supported Internship.

Progression: You can move onto a Level 1 study programme, onto the Preparation for Independent Living & Work study programme, or a Supported Introductory programme.



Level 1 courses give you the chance to learn new, hands-on skills in many industries, to get started and build practical knowledge that can lead straight into a job or further training. We focus heavily on developing your employability, independence and confidence to allow you to thrive in your chosen industry.

Entry requirements: Predominantly GCSEs at Grade 2 or equivalent, preferably including Maths and English Language. Please check our website for further information.



Types of course: BTEC Level 1 Diploma, Certificate, Project Search, Functional Skills.

Progression: You can progress onto Level 2 courses such as vocational qualifications, Functional Skills, apprenticeships, or employment.



Level 2 qualifications will start to provide further focus on a subject that can support the transition to a Level 3 qualification, apprenticeship and employment.

Entry Requirements: Predominantly GCSEs at Grade 3 or equivalent, preferably including Maths and English Language. Please check our website for further information.

Types of course: Level 2 BTEC, Diploma, GCSE, Apprenticeship, Academic Progression, SUTA.

Progression: You can move onto a full time Level 3 vocational course, such as a BTEC, Diploma or T Level, an apprenticeship or employment. From SUTA and Academic Progression you can progress onto any Level 3 qualification.

Level 3:

Level 3 courses will set you on a path to university, higher apprenticeships or skilled employment.

Entry Requirements: Predominantly GCSEs at Grade 4 or equivalent, including Maths and English Language. Please check our website for further information.

Types of course: A Levels, T Levels, BTECs, vocational qualifications, advanced apprenticeships, and Access to Higher Education Diplomas.

Progression: You can progress onto university, an apprenticeship or onto employment.

LEVELS 4-6 are university-level qualifications:

Foundation degree (Year 1), honours degree (Year 1), higher apprenticeship degree apprenticeship, HNC, HND, professional qualifications.



Please remember that the entry requirements detailed above are a guide. During the application process, we will ask you about your predicted grades and these will be used to offer you the most appropriate level course. If you then achieve a higher or lower grade, we may adjust the level of your course accordingly to help you attain your best result. If you do not achieve a GCSE grade 4 in Maths and/or English Language, you will continue studying these subjects alongside your chosen entry level, Level 1 or Level 2 courses.

CHILDCARE SUPPORT

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS



We understand that preparing for your next steps is exciting but can also seem daunting. Please do not worry - here are some answers to questions you may have, and if you have any further queries, get in touch with us.

I am undecided about which course to study. Is there someone who can help me?

Yes! We have a dedicated School Liaison team who can meet you at school to discuss your options and help you to apply as well as our friendly Advice & Guidance team who can offer advice and application assistance. We run open events throughout the year, which are a great way to come and explore our campus and talk to our lecturers about the courses available to you.

When do I apply for my course?

Applications open in October and are accepted throughout the academic year before starting in September. We recommend everyone apply as soon as possible so that interviews can take place before GCSE revision and exams start.

I can't decide on one course - can I apply for more than one course?

Yes. You can apply for more than one course to keep your options open and finalise your decision later in the academic year.

Can I apply to more than one college?

Yes, you can apply to more than one college. We would recommend you visit different colleges to get a "feel" for what suits you best.

What happens if I change my mind about my course after applying?

Just call or email us, and we will withdraw your original application and amend it to the new course you want to study.

Do I have to have an interview?

Yes, but please don't worry - this is the opportunity to meet your lecturer and discuss any queries you may have about the course. Your lecturer will ask you about why you have applied, your future plans and your career aspirations to ensure it is the right course for you.

Can I come and have a look around Petroc?

Yes, we host open events throughout the Autumn and Spring terms where you can come and explore our facilities, workshops, teaching and social spaces. Additionally, our friendly School Liaison team are happy to show you around in a private tour if you prefer.

What happens if I do not get the GCSE grades to meet the entry requirements for my course?

Don't panic! On GCSE results day, upload your results, and our team will contact you to discuss your options. We will find a course for you!

How many days a week will I have to be at college?

This varies by course, and you will be able to discuss this during your interview. Most courses run over 3 - 4 days, allowing plenty of time to fit in part-time jobs, independent study, work experience, and extracurricular activities.

When do I receive my timetable?

You will receive this during your enrolment days at the end of August.





How many people will be in my class?

Class sizes vary between 10 - 20 students per class, depending on the course.

How can I get to Petroc?

When does college start?

In September! We will let you know your start date, and you will receive your timetable and lanyard before starting, along with any other information that you need to know.

What support is available for students with learning difficulties, mental health or additional needs?

Petroc offers dedicated support for every student. If you have an EHCP, our specialist mentors will work with your school or home setting to ensure a smooth transition. Our Additional Learning Support, SEND, Wellbeing, and Safeguarding Teams also collaborate with schools, families and individuals to provide help with starting college and ongoing support throughout your time at college.

Can I change my course if I start in September and realise it's not right for me?

Yes, within the first 3 weeks of the Autumn term, if you feel the course you are studying is not right for you, you will have the opportunity to discuss transferring to another course.

I received free school meals at school; will I at college?

All students receive a free breakfast at college across all of our campuses. A bursary fund is available to support learners from low-income families and covers costs for items such as college meals, bus passes, equipment, books, residentials and trip fees. Find out more information here.



Is there an opportunity to travel abroad during my time at Petroc?

Petroc Go offers students the chance to spend up to 15 days abroad, gaining valuable training and work experience across the world.

We currently partner with seven organisations to give you many opportunities, for example, learning to ski in Avoriaz, France or working with a voluntary organisation in Bali. We also provide supported work experience in Sweden, Slovenia and Spain if you have learning difficulties and disabilities.

Is there an opportunity for work experience whilst studying my course at Petroc?

All courses include work experience as an essential part of your study programme and hours will vary depending on the course studied.

COUNTDOWN TO COLLEGE



1. Apply

Visit **petroc.ac.uk**, add your chosen course/s to your basket, and complete the application form. You can apply for two vocational courses and/or 3 A Levels, so don't worry if you're still undecided on the route you would like to take. An email will then be sent to you to confirm your application and provide you with an interview date, so keep an eye on your emails.



2. Interview

You will be invited to an interview with the course lecturer to discuss your chosen course and to check if it is the right course for you. This is a chance to discuss your predicted grades and any queries you may have about life at Petroc.



3. Accept your Offer

Following your interview, you will be offered a conditional place on your chosen course, subject to gaining the entry requirements needed.



t. Results Day Once you receive your results, make sure you input them into your **myPetroc** account to confirm your place. If you don't achieve your expected grades, please don't worry; simply contact us, and we can discuss your options.



5. Attend your to start y to start y of term.

In August, you will attend an enrolment event to ensure you are ready to start your course. We will help you set up your student account and receive your ID card. You'll also get your timetable before the start of term.




