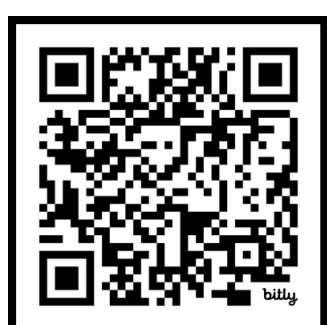
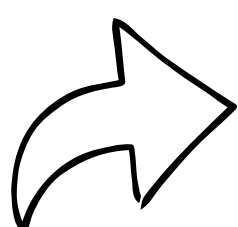

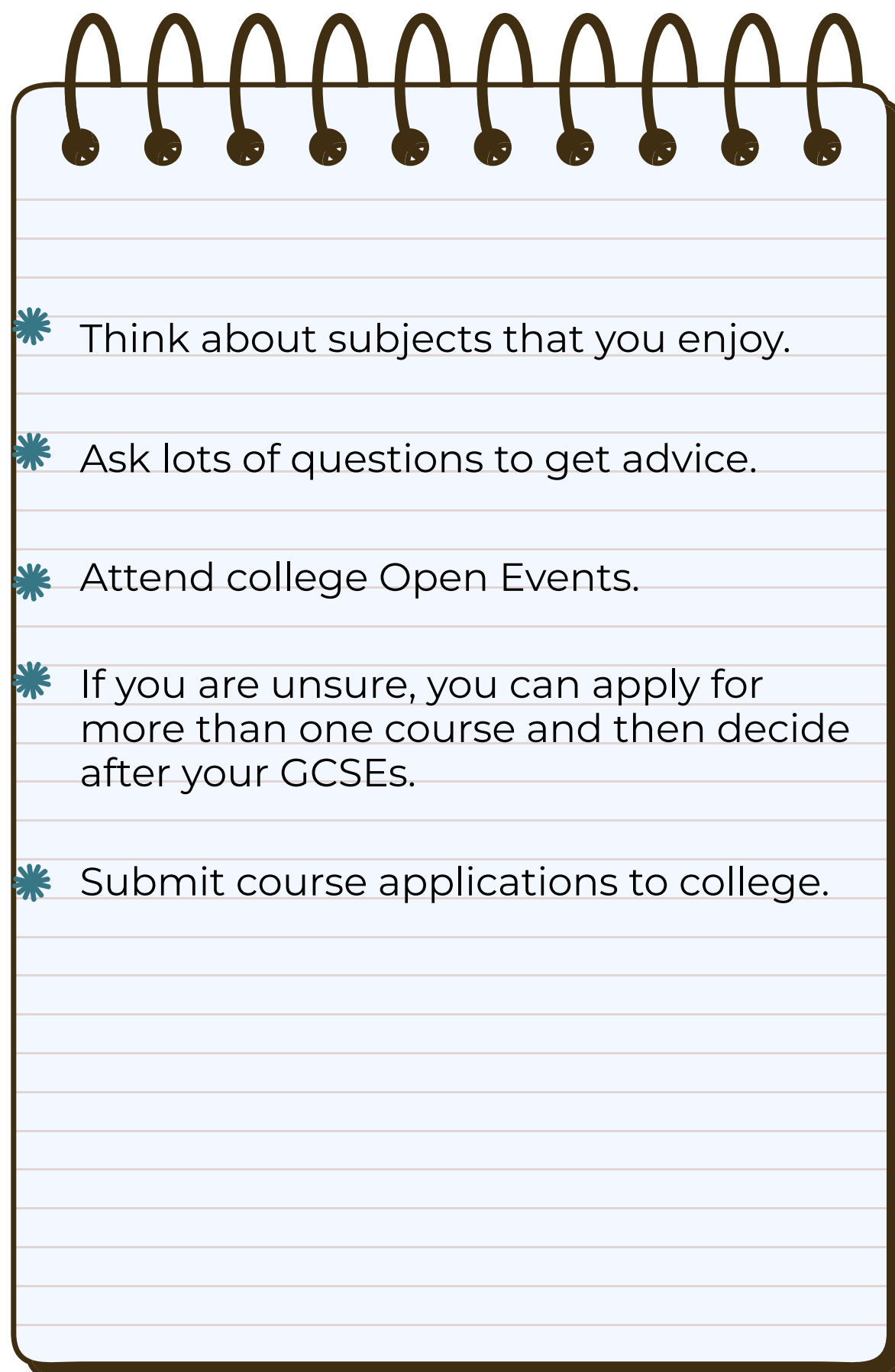

Tips on choosing your course:



- * Think about subjects that you enjoy.
- * Ask lots of questions to get advice.
- * Attend college Open Events.
- * If you are unsure, you can apply for more than one course and then decide after your GCSEs.
- * Submit course applications to college.

What happens once you apply?

- After your application is confirmed, North Devon College will email you to invite you to an interview with the course lecturer. This is for the lecturer to talk to you and ask a little bit more about your learning needs. It's also a chance for you to ask any questions you might have too.
- If the interview is successful, you will receive an offer by email, for you to accept.
- If you are not offered a place on your first choice, a member of staff will be available to talk through your options, helping to find a suitable course.
